What is penergetic coat

1. What is penergetic coat?

penergetic coat is a seed dressing.

2. How does penergetic coat work?

Penergetic Coat acts directly on the vitality of the seeds. The product formulation consists of Sikron (a vehicle for Penergetic technology) and a compound of minerals (trace elements) selected to intensify the action on the seed and regulate the osmotic and physiological processes responsible for the germination process.

penergetic coat increases germination and vitality, resulting in healthier and more energetic plants in the early stages of growth, both root and shoot.

In addition to stimulating rooting, penergetic coat promotes better conditions for microbial symbiosis and forms a rhizosphere rich in biological activity. These effects, which occur at the beginning of plant development, are very important for maintaining plant quality until the final stages of harvest cycles.

penergetic coat is synonymous with protection, stimulation and vitality of seeds and plants.

3. Where is penergetic coat used?

All seeds can be dressed in penergetic coat.

4. Can penergetic coat be combined with penergetic p and penergetic b?

Yes. The application periods can be taken from the respective spraying schedules.

5. Why to use penergetic coat?

Nematodes are native in every arable soil. Not all of them are dangerous for plant growth. Those which damage the plant roots are in the uppermost approx. 10cm. The faster the seeds germinate, the faster their roots can go through the damaging layer. Via this effect the nematode infestation in the roots is noticeably reduced.

Note: Every 1% increase in the germination capacity of the seed corresponds to a yield increase of 1.5 to 2%!

6. Is penergetic coat harmful for the environment?

Since penergetic coat contains chemical components, and some of them are harmful to the environment, the requirements for storage and disposal must be observed (see SDS).

7. What is penergetic coat made of?

- The main components are water, Sikron and trace elements.

8. Can penergetic coat be mixed with other seed dressings?

In general, yes. But not with oily substances.

Recommendation

9. Dosage

The dosage is 3ml penergetic coat per 1kg of seeds.

10. Which registrations are available for Switzerland?

Penergetic coat is registered as a trace nutrient fertilizer in Switzerland.

11. What is the expiry date for penergetic coat?

From date of manufacturing 24 months.

12. What must be respected during storage?

- Store in a cool and dry place. Store on wood.
- Do not store the product directly on metal!
- Tightly reseal opened packages.
- Reuse of the package is prohibited.
- Do not store near electromagnetic sources.
- Keep safe from children
